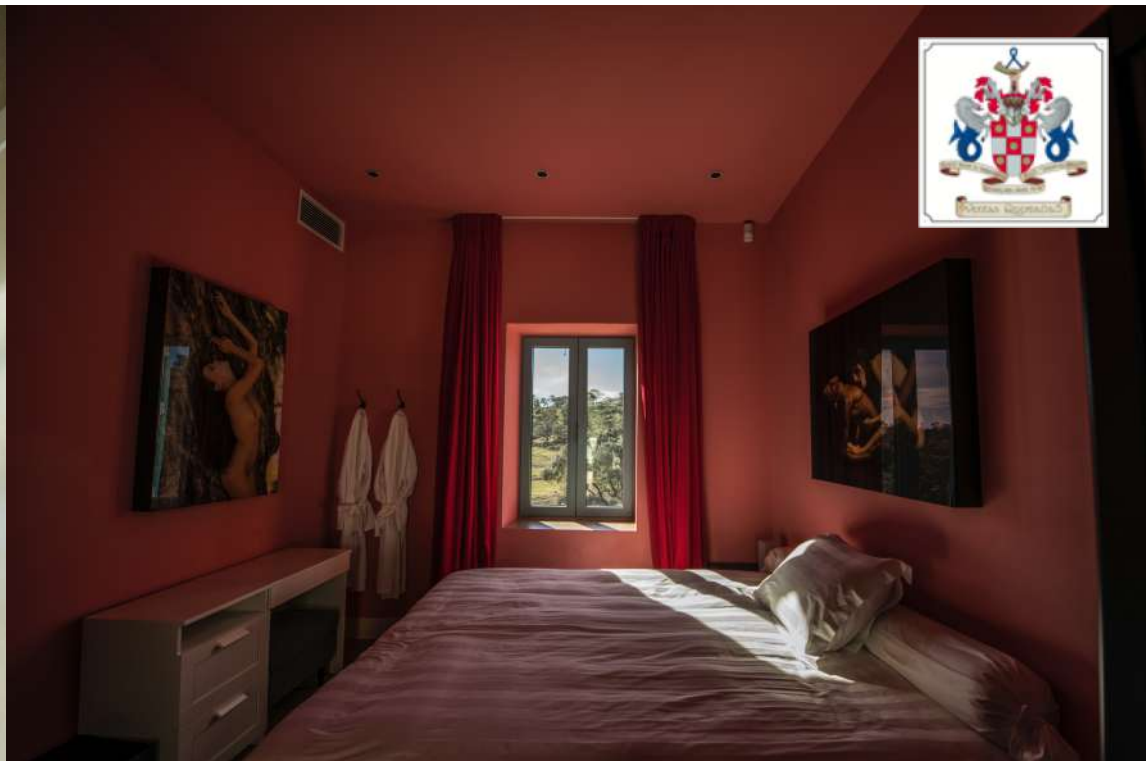












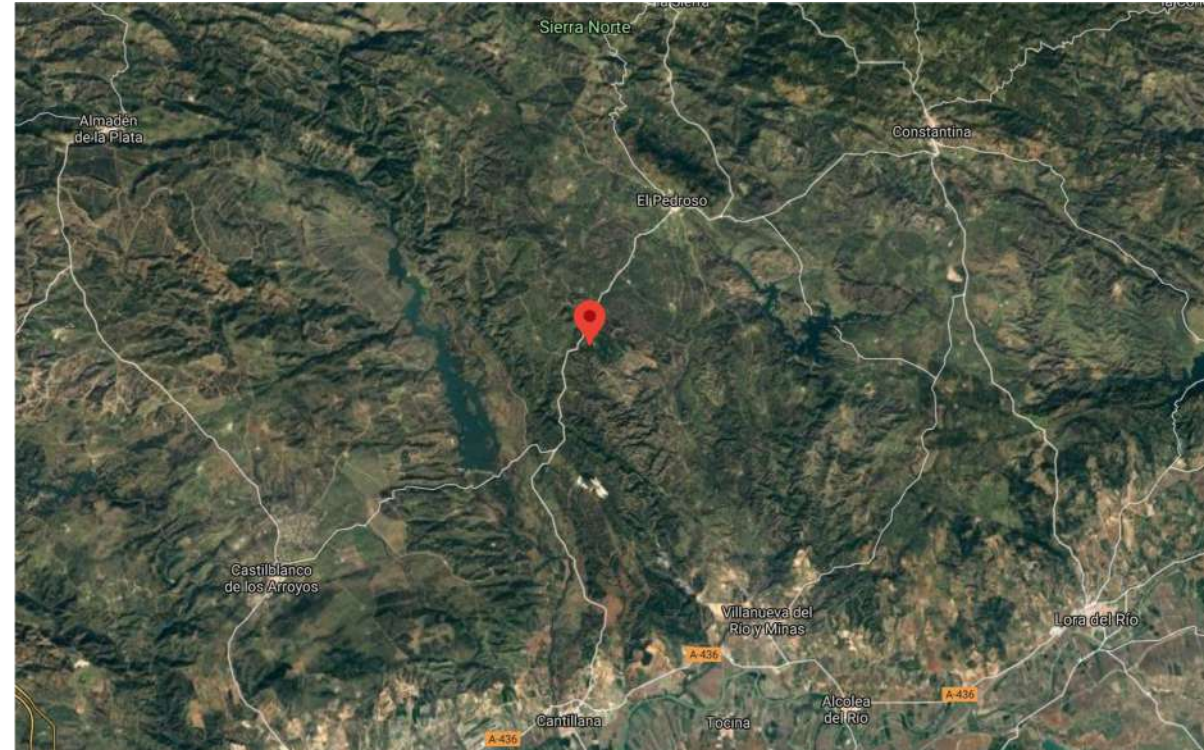




LOCATION




Ventas Quemadas is a privately-owned country estate of 4500 hectares in a superb geographical location, between Cantillana and El Pedroso, only 45 minutes from Sevilla Airport.

The estate is located 30 minutes from the AVE (high-speed train) station in Cordoba . Tha AVE (train) from Madrid takes 2 hours and 30 minutes and has a frequency every 30 minutes.

Cordoba has a private airport, which is 1 hour 15 minutes far from the estate.

The weather is very pleasant. During the season, the temperature generally varies from 6°C and 20°C.





THE DRIVES AND THE SHOOTING



The setting of the estate is incomparable for partridge shooting. It is formed by very undulating and abrupt mountains which provide some of the most challenging partridges in Spain. The partridges are flushed off high hills to produce some stunning bird flights.



The changing terrain and topography are by themselves, able to offer a great variety of drives ensuring top quality days of partridge shooting. So great is the movement of the landscape and hábitat that the range of drives is unlimited.







SHOOTING AT VENTAS QUEMADAS



Guests normally meet for breakfast at 9:00h, and then leave the estate home for shooting. We start with two drives, after which we have a break for the 'taco' (picnic). After the taco we have another two drives, and we are off for an afternoon tea and to get ready for drinks and a formal dinner .

Dinner is served in the dining room before resuming the afternoon drives. If guests require a different program we can tailor the Schedule to fit our guests' requirements. We guarantee you will have unforgettable memories of your stay with us.











MEZQUITA DE CÓRDOBA

The 'Mezquita' Mosque-Cathedral in Córdoba is one of the top sights to see in Andalucía.

In 784 Abd Al-Rahman I ordered the construction of the Great Mosque, which was expanded by later Muslim rulers. Córdoba returned to Christian rule in 1236 during the Reconquista, and the building was converted to a Catholic church, culminating in the insertion of a Renaissance Cathedral nave in the 16th century.



CATEDRAL DE SEVILLA

The 'Catedral de Sevilla' is also a UNESCO World Heritage Site.

Known as the cathedral of st. Mary of the sea, it is the largest gothic cathedral in the world and the third christian temple after st. Peter's in Rome and st. Paul's in London.



ALCÁZAR DE SEVILLA

The 'Real Alcazar de Sevilla' is a UNESCO World Heritage Site since 1987.

The architecture offers a great stylistic variety, bringing together elements of muslim, gothic, renaissance, baroque and romantic art; product of the mixture of islamic and christian cultures.
