# INTRODUCTION

## LOS QUINTOS

Los Quintos is probably the most famous and exclusive wild partridge estate in Spain.

In its more than 8000 hectares, the most mythical and legendary shootings that have been written in the hunting history of our country have been held.

For more than 10 years, Ventosilla has managed and organized, season after season, partridge shooting on this prestigious estate.

We only organize between 5 and 6 shoots per year, for lines of shooters between 4 and 7 guns.

The shootings are organized in the following way 4 drives on the first day and 3 drives on the second day. More than 100 beaters and 8 horse guards are used. Quite a show.

Depending on the years, and the breeding, we keep really exceptional figures.

The season runs from October 12th to January 31st.

The lodge has been completely renovated and offers exceptional qualities.

There is no commercial shoot like this today. It is probably the most exclusive commercial shoot in the world.



**Surface  
Estate:  
8.000 ha**

**Los Quintos** is located on both sides of the EX103 regional highway running from Llerena to Castuera at km 65 within the municipal area of Valencia de las Torres, Province of Badajoz, Autonomous Community of Extremadura.

The estate is 41 km or some 20 minutes from the A66 dual carriageway (Ruta de la Plata). From the centre of Sevilla or Cordoba it takes just one and one-half hours and is about 45 minutes from Merida.

Los Quintos de San Martín was bought in 1973 by José Ramón Mora-Figueroa, Fermín Bohórquez and Juan Cucarella. In just two years they attempted its first driven partridge shoot. After this trial, this estate's special conditions of raising birds and the beauty of the driven hunts was confirmed.

Activities that take place in the various estates making up the property include dairy sheep production with its associated pasture areas, rabbit and partridge rearing areas, large and small game hunting reserves as well as areas for agricultural use and leisure. In addition, there are facilities for electrical distribution and water collection and distribution.

The estate has an approximate gross Surface of 8,000 hectares(ha). Of this Surface area, 2,000 ha have been planted from 1999 to 2008 with non-irrigated plurianual grasses and are of different degrees of maturity. 375 ha are reforestation of holm oak planted in 1994, 1995 and 2002. 450 ha are uncultivated pasture and 450 ha are low scrubland. The rest of the Surface area (4,825ha) is comprised of oak Woods with varying tree densities and sizes.
